1911 R.L.Polk Directory has him listed as living at 500 Garfield Ave. in Bay City. William G. Carney remembers his grandmother, who lived at 519 Garfield, mentioning this when he was young. Also listed at that address is a William J. Carney, a bricklayer. Grandma Katie says that there were a number of masons and bricklayers in the family. Nickname was "Pete", for some reason. No one living knows why.
Dorothy was his third wife.

Catherine Cobley told me that he was a bar owner in downtown Detroit.

William George Carney said he owned a bar at the foot of the bridge to Belle Isle in Detroit.

1915 Bay County Circuit Court Records, #5623 Pg 22. Iza Carney vs. William Carney. Married June 14, 1911 in Bay City. One child. Wife=Claimant. Filed on June 5, 1914, final action taken on March 13, 1915. Alleged cause of divorce, drunkenness and cruelty. Not contested.
